

The State of Maryland to wit whereas Benjamin Ringgold has been committed to Baltimore County Gaol on a charge of breaking open the office of Jonathan Sleeper and stealing therefrom four yards of Broad Cloth Twenty two yards of Calico, Ladies Stipped Gold Seal and Key the property of said Sleeper, and whereas the Honourable John Scott Chief Judge of the Court of Oyer and Terminer and Gaol delivery for Baltimore County has prayed that I would grant a Noli Prosequi to said Benjamin Ringgold on condition of his enlisting in the Navy of the United States - I have therefore thought proper to order and direct that all proceedings at law against the said Benjamin Ringgold do cease and determine and that no further prosecution be had or carried on against the said Benjamin Ringgold for or on account of the same on this express condition that the said Benjamin Ringgold before the second Monday in July next enlist for two years on board some vessel in the United Service of the United States and if the said Benjamin Ringgold do not fully and strictly comply with the conditions aforesaid then this Noli Prosequi to be void and of no effect so that no benefit or advantage shall arise to the said Benjamin Ringgold from the same or any part thereof.
