October 28th 1811

Death warrant issued for the Execution of Negro John
Alias John Armstrong for the murder of William Robinson
of Queen Anne's County. Execution to be on Wednesday the
sixth of November eighteen Hundred and eleven

The State of Maryland do wit whereas Isaac Smyly has
been sentenced to four Months imprisonment by the Court of
Queen and Terminus and Goal Delivery for Baltimore County
for committing an assault on his wife - and whereas it has been
represented to me that the said Isaac Smyly has lived with his
said wife for upwards of twenty years without even an allegation ha-
ving been made against him for ill treatment to her previous
to the present charge - and whereas it appears that more than
one month has elapsed since the said sentence was passed and
that he is truly penitent for the said offence - I have therefore
for those reasons as well as on account of the respectable recommen-
dation in his favour thought proper to pardon the said Isaac Smyly
for the offence aforesaid and do hereby order and direct that he
be released from the Punishment to which he hath been adjudged
Given under my hand and the Seal of the State of Maryland
the sixth day of December in the year of our Lord one thousand
eight Hundred and Eleven
