the interposition of Government in his favour. I have therefore
thought proper to order and direct that all proceedings at law
against the said William M. Heath do cease and determine
and that no further prosecution be had or carried against him

The State of Maryland to wit whereas Dewey Russell has
been committed to the Gaol of Baltimore County on a charge of
stealing a Great Boat the property of John Rogers and whereas
the said Dewey Russell has prayed that I would grant him
a Noli Prosequi on condition of his enlisting in the service of
the United States, I have thought proper to order and direct
that all proceedings at law against the said Dewey Russell
do cease and determine and that no further prosecution
be had or carried on against him for or on account of the said
offence on this express condition that the said Dewey Russell do enlist for
three years in the army of the United States and if the said Dewey Russell
do not fully and strictly comply with the condition aforesaid then this
Noli Prosequi to be void and of no effect so that no benefit or advan-
tage shall arise to the said Dewey Russell from the same or any
