The State of Maryland to wit whereas at a Court of Oyer and Terminer and Gaol Delivery for Baltimore County holden on the second Monday of July eighteen hundred and twelve a certain James Thompson was indicted and charged with being present aiding and abetting a certain Richard Carroll also alleged to have killed a certain Samuel Knight and whereas a *Mot Prosequi* has heretofore been granted to the said Richard Carroll by his Excellency Robert Bowie and a *Mot Prosequi* had been previously granted by his Excellency Edward Lloyd to a certain Charles Herrell Bridgely the second of said Samuel Knight in the duel wherein the said Knight fell I have therefore thought proper to order and direct that all proceedings at law against the said James Thompson for or on account of the said offence
