Chattels of a certain Daniel Fowle. And whereas Twenty one of
the Grand Jury, The Attorney General and a number of respectable
persons inhabitants of the said County have recommended the
said Mary Crawford to me as a fit object for the interposition of
Government. I have therefore thought proper to order and direct
that all proceedings at Law against the said Mary Crawford do cease
and determine, and that no further prosecution be had or carried
on against her for or on account of the same. Given under my hand

and thirteen

therefore thought proper to pardon the said Nicholas Remington for
the offence aforesaid, and direct that he be released from the confine-
