

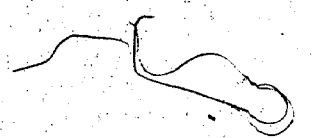
Leonard Storm Junior in one case for keeping a Pharo table

the same Penitentiary. And whereas the Chief, and two
Associate Judges of the said Court, several of the Jury and
a number of respectable persons inhabitants of Frederick
County, have recommended the said Hilleary Hally,
James Campbell, and Leonard Storm Junior, to me
as fit objects for the interposition of Government. I
have therefore thought proper to pardon the said
Hilleary Hally, James Campbell and Leonard Storm
Junior for the offences aforesaid and do hereby order and
direct that they be released from the punishments to
which they have been adjudged. Given under my hand
