The State of Maryland to wit. Whereas Alexis Romain  
and his wife Ursula Romain stand charged with receiving  
stolen goods the property of William Gwynn and Nathaniel  
H. Clifford of the city of Baltimore and whereas the Attorney  
General of the State of Maryland, William Gwynn and  
Nathaniel H. Clifford, from whom the goods were stolen  
have together with a number of respectable persons inhabitants  
of the City of Baltimore recommended the said Alexis  
Romain and Ursula Romain as fit objects for the interposition  
of Government. I have therefore thought proper to order and  
direct that all proceedings at law against the said Alexis  
Romain and Ursula Romain do cease and determine and  
that no further prosecution be had or carried on against them  
for or on account of the said offences. Given under my hand  
and the Seal of the State of Maryland this fourteenth day  
of July in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred  
and fifteen
