People to whom these Presents shall come greeting.
Whereas Charlotte Elliott was sentenced by the Court of
Bye and Terminus and Gaol delivery for Baltimore
County on the sixteenth day of November last to one year
confinement in the Penitentiary house in Baltimore County
and whereas eight of the Inspectors of the said Pen-
itentiary have stated to me that the conduct of the
said Charlotte Elliott since her confinement has been
orderly and penitent and have recommended her
to me as a fit object for mercy - I have therefore thought
proper to pardon the said Charlotte Elliott for the offence
aforesaid and do order and direct that that she be releas-
ed from the residue of the confinement to which she hath
been adjudged. Given under my hand and the seal
of the State of Maryland this third day of January in
the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and
sixteen
