Province be and he is hereby desired and appointed to Issue out unto the  
said Osborn a new Commission for the said Office of Deputy Surveyor  
under him the said George Talbot Esq<sup>r</sup> for and in the several parts and  
Places in the said former Commission named and further up to, and in  
and about Dutch Creek in Delaware Bay
