Whereas the third day of October 1670 Ralph Elstone Junior
had Surveyed for him three hundred acres of Land called Love and
also Ralph Elstone Senior three hundred acres called Uplown both lying
together in Worcester County for which no Rights have yet been made
good And Whereas your Honours petitioners hath purchased their Interest
in the said Land

Your Honours petitioners therefore humbly prays that Patent
may Issue for the whole to your Petitioner he making good Rights
for the same And your Honours petitioners shall pray &

The Petitioner making good and complying with his Lordships
Conditions of Plantation now in force within this Province for the Lands
in the Petition mentioned Ordered that Patents be granted him for the same
