The humble Petition of John Richardson of Durham County
Humbly Sheweth. That your Petitioner having had his Plantations
taken from him by John Stevens himself, wife and children left
Miserable and Poor without your Lordships Grace and Favour

Which your Lordships Petitioner humbly begs your Lordships
to touchase unto him by granting unto him a Conditional Warrant
for three thousand Acres of Land not already taken up nor reserved
for your Lordships Use and three years time to make good Rights
for the same and that upon Provon of the Certificate or Certificates
of Survey for any Land taken up by virtue thereof your Lordships
Letters patents may issue for the same to him his heirs and assigns
for ever he making good Rights for the same as aforesaid

And as in Duty bound he shall pray
