purchase Know ye that We willing to give due Encouragement
to the Subjects of those States do hereby declare him the said Jacob
Clayson to be a free Denizen of this our Province of Maryland and
do further for Us our Heirs and Successors straightly Enjoin Constitute
Ordain and Command that the said Jacob Clayson be in all things
Held, Treated, Reputed and Esteemed as one of the faithful People of
Us our Heirs and Successors born within this our province of Maryland
and likewise any Lands, Tenements, Revenues, Services and other Heredi-
taments whatsoever within our said province of Maryland may Inherit
or otherwise purchase, Receive, Take, Have, Hold Buy and Possess and them
may Occupy and Enjoy, Give, Sell, Alien and Bequeath as likewise all
Liberties, Franchises and priviledges of this our province of Maryland
freely quietly and peaceably have and possess Occupy and Enjoy as our
faithful People Born or to be Born within our said province of Maryland
without the full Molestation, Peccation Trouble or Grievance of Us our
Heirs and Successors any Custom to the contrary hereof in anywise
Notwithstanding Given at Swidd Marye under the Great Seal of our
said province of Maryland this 30th day of July In the 30th year of
our Dominion over the said province of Maryland Anno Domini 1661
