

Name of ~~S. Austin~~ Manner which was by your Lordships Special Warrants of the fifth day of April Anno 1671 further confirmed by Ordering that the same should be laid out to none other but the said Augustine Herman positively as may appeared

Notwithstanding which the same is all or great part thereof taken up Seated and Inhabited by others under his Royal Highness Government Your Petitioner (to whom the said Land is assigned by the said Augustine Herman his Father) no ways willing or desirous to disturb or molest any person or persons that have taken up, Seated, or Inhabited the same as aforesaid in their peaceable and quiet possession thereof, but without sensible off, and in humble manner acknowledging

Your Lordships Right and Dominion thereunto and other the parts thereto adjacent, and being most ready and willing in all dutiful Obedience to submit himself to the same and be received into your Lordships most gracious protection and Government most humbly Offers to your Lordships Consideration that there is another Neck of Land between Saint Georges and Opoquenunmin Creek, Bounded on the East with the Delaware River, on the South with Opoquenunmin Creek, to the Head thereof, on the West with Bohemia Manner and the Head of Back Creek, and on the North with a Cart Road leading from said Back Creek to Jacob Youngs and S^t Georges Creek, which for some part thereof is yet Untaken up

Your Petitioner therefore humbly prays your Lordships Consideration of the premises so as in Lieu of the aforesaid Grant to your Petitioner said Father) to give and Grant unto your Petitioner the last mentioned Neck or Tract of Land between Saint Georges and Opoquenunmin Creek aforesaid according to the Bounds above specified to be erected into a Manner by the Name of Saint Austins Manner as before upon such reasonable Fees and Services as your Lordship in your abundant Goodness shall think fit Reserving unto all Persons that have already taken up and Seated upon or within the same or any part thereof and that shall here and Acknowledge your Lordships Right and Dominion thereunto and submit themselves to your Lordships Protection Rule and Government their Equitable Right
