

respectively do not or shall not within four years to be accounted from the day of the date of such grant or grants respectively bring in or transport into the said Province to Reside and Continue there one Person of British or Irish Descent for every fifty Acres so to be granted upon Credit as aforesaid and make sufficient Legall Proof of such bringing in and transportation of every such Person

3. That notwithstanding any reservation made by his Lordship or his Lordships Surveyor General for his Lordships use of any Lands on either side of Mount Scarborough in the County of Somerset within the said Province you shall forthwith make good all Articles made by our Dear Brother Phillip Calvert Esq on his Lordships Behalf and Coll: Edmund Scarborough upon the laying out of the Bounds between his Lordships said Province and the Province of Virginia in relation to the granting of any the Lands in and by the said Articles agreed to be granted to any person or persons whatsoever at the time of the making the said Articles so as the said Grants be made according to his Lordships Conditions of Plantations before His Lordships Instructions above mentioned bearing date the 28th of July 1669 and so as all Royall Minors be Excepted in every such Grant Given under his Lordships Hand and lesser Seal at Armes this one and twentieth day of March 1669/70
