What am I to doe in case of the Indians who threaten'd me
and how am I to learn who sett them on? Written Instructions
how to proceed will be necessary.

Answer:

You must use your endeav^{rs}. according to your discretion to
find out the Indian, and when found out to secure him & send
him down to his S^{ty} and Council; and to let that whole nation
know that they are within his S^{ty}s Dominions and Governm^{ts}
that his S^{ty} expects acknowledgem^{ts} from them and for that
reason you are sent thither, or if it had been otherwise you
should have been directed to have made your applications to
Another Governm^{ts} for Satisfaction.
