Imp<sup>ts</sup> - You are to use your utmost Skill and endeavour for the sealing and Inhabiting of the seabord side Delaware Bay and River up to the fourtieth degree of Northern Latitude, and more especially of those parts at the Whore hills by persons of British or Irish Descent

2<sup>dly</sup> - For the better effecting whereof and encouragem<sup>t</sup> of all undertakers therein We do authorize and Empower you, and you have full power and Authority hereby given you by warrant under your hand and Seal to permitt any person or persons of the descent aforesaid to take up any Quantity or Qualities of Land not exceeding the number of five hundred acres to any one person in any the aforementioned places, he or they paying or securing to be paid unto us or our Heires or such Officer or Officers as shall be appointed by us and our Heires from time to time to Collect the same the Quantity of One Hundred
