Province of Maryland —

1st Qu: You are to use your utmost endeavour for the halting
and Inhabiting of the leabord side Delaware Bay and River
up to the fortieth degree of Northern Latitude, and more especi-
ally of those parts at the Whore hills by persons of Britishe
or Irish Descent

2^d Qu: For the better effecting whereof and encouragement of all under-
takers therein We do authorise and Empower you, and you
have full power and Authority hereby given you by warrant
under your hand and Seal to permit any person or persons
of the descent aforesaid to take up any quantity or qualities
of Land not exceeding the number of five hundred acres to
any one person in any the aforesmentioned parts, he or they
paying or securing to be paid unto us or our Heires or such
Officer or Officers as shall be appointed by us and our Heires
from time to time to collect the same the Quantity of One
(hundred)
