from all others claiming to their Lands, or Rents; We do hereby also constitute and appoint you the said George Salbott Deputy for us of the North and North East Confiners of this our Province, hereby authorizing and requiring you to use the utmost of your Skill, Industry and power to prevent and hinder the Infrachments of William Penn Esq. Governour and Propriety of Pennsylvania and his partakers on the Confiners and borders aforesaid which end you are required to observe the Instructions formerly given you dated the 12th Instant and your latter Instructions bearing equal date herewith in building and peopling of houses and building plantations at our charge in convenient vacant places near the Confiners aforesaid and more particularly in one place mentioned in the said Instructions, and the said houses soe built to keepe preserve and defend to our Use, to y^e utmost of your industry and power We doe also require and authorize you to appoint by warrants under your hand and Seal as many rangers and forresters in the Confiners aforesaid as you shall think necessary for killing and taking up to our use all wild unmarket Cattle, horses, Mares, Colts, and Swine allowing the said Rangers and Forresters such a part the said Wilds for their paines as you shall think fit and you are also to hinder al others from Ranging who can produce noe Commission or warrant from and under us and more especially such as shall range in our Forrest and the uninhabited parts of our Confiners aforesaid by vesting of warrants from or under the Governour of Pennsylvania or his Officer you are also to use such means for securing your self your family and Neighbour from the force and treachery of the Indians, and to compell the Indians of Christine and white-clay Creek within our Province to an acknowledgem^t of our Jurisdiction as are already prescribed to you in the Instructions above mentioned And for soe doing this shall be your Commission and warrant Given under our hand and lesser Seal at Annapolis the Nineteenth day of March 1683 -
