North and Deputy for us of the North and North East Confines of this
North East Province, hereby authorizing and requiring you to use
the utmost of your Skill Industry and power to prevent and
hinder the Importation of William Penn Esq; Governor &c & the
Property of Pennsylvania and his partakers on the Eastern & m
borders aforesaid which and you are required to observe the
Instructions formerly given you dated the 12th instant and
your latter Instructions bearing date here-
with in building and peopleing of houses and settling plan-
tations at our charge in convenient vacant places near the
Confines aforesaid and more particularly in one place men-
tioned in the said Instructions, and the said houses to be
built to keepe preserve and defend to our Use, to y^e interest
of your industry and power We do also require and au-
thorise you to appoint by warrants under your hand and
Seal as many rangers and forresters in the Confines afores-
aid as you shall think necessary for killing and taking
up to our use all wild unmett cattle, horses, Mares, Cotts,
and Swine abounding the said Rangers and forresters such a-
part the said Wild for their pastures as you shall think fit and
you are also to hinder all others from Rangeing who can
produce noe Commission or warrant from and under us and
more especially such as shall range in our forrests and the
uninhabited parts of our Confines aforesaid by virtue of war-
rants from or under the Governo^r of Pennsylvania or his Officers
you are also to use such meanes for Securing your self your
family and Neighbours from the force and treachery of the
Indians, and to compell the Indians of Christline and white-
clay Creek within our Province to an acknowledg^m off
our Jurisdiction as are already prescribed to you in the In-
structions above mentioned And for see doing this shall
be your Commission and warrant Given under our hand and
Seal at Annes the Nineteenth day of March 1683 —
