That your Petitioner by Patent as afo bearing date
the 17th day of November 1679 hath granted to him Three Several Lots
of Ground in the afo Town of New Castle formerly belonging to Captain
John Carrutting and Bounding as in the said Patent is set forth as
may appear etc.

And by Patent as afo bearing Date 25th Day of March
1676 hath granted to him one other Lot of Ground in New Castle afo
being the place where the Magazine House stood according to the limits
and Bounds in the said Patent mentioned.

That William Tomm by Patent as afo bearing Date the
25th Day of July 1669 had granted unto him a certain House and Lot
at New Castle afo formerly belonging to Peter Alrick as also half a
Lot of Ground in the said Town where formerly the Mill stood butting
and Bounding as in the said Patent is expressly set forth which
house and half a Lot next to Peter Alrick's new dwelling house was
by the said William Tomm assigned and set over unto Martin
Rosemond who also sold the same to John Edmondson and John
Edmondson to your Petitioner in whose possession the same and each
and every the aforementioned Tracts or parcels or Lots of Land now
is and are in manner afo etc.

NOW it may please your Lordship your Petitioner
being informed and made sensible that all and every the aforementioned
parcels and Lots of Land and Premises and other the Lands thereunto
Adjacent are within the Bounds of this your Lordships Province of
Maryland most humbly prays your Lordship to accept of your petition
most sincere and hearty inclinations and Resolutions to acknowledge
and submit unto your Lordships right and Dominion thereunto and to
be Received into your Lordships most gracious protection and that your
Lordship (in Consideration of your Petitioner's equitable Right with the
Premises and to preserve the same unto your Petitioner) would favourably
please to Reserve the same entire to your Petitioner from any other
person or persons whatsoever coming after until such time as your
Petitioner shall have opportunity to see forth your Lordships Letters
Patents of Confirmation thereof which he likewise with all Humility
Supplicates your Lordship may be granted unto him upon Conditions
of plantation now in force within this your Province etc.
