

killing Cattle about Potomac river and those quarters as appears by the Informant  
of Robert Gornuch taken 13<sup>th</sup> May 1661 Resolved that all further demands of  
Satisfaction for those Cattle be waived and that Suff<sup>ce</sup> Provision in the Articles of  
be made for the Security of our Stocks of Cattle and Hogs for the future and  
that the Treaty be immediately begun least Gen<sup>l</sup> Significant of Manhatans  
make an Advantage by these Indians as it being doubled whether there  
be a war between Holland and England or not

Articles of Peace and Amity concluded between  
the Hon<sup>ble</sup> Philip Calvert Esq<sup>r</sup> Governor and Henry Courney  
Secretary and Mr<sup>r</sup> John Ballman Counciler for the behalf  
of the Lord Proprietors of this Province of Maryland  
and Pinna King of Pashanonia on the behalf of the  
Cassayouke Indians on the other part

N<sup>o</sup> 13 Imprimis That there shall be a perpetual Peace betwixt the  
People of Maryland and the Cassayouke Indians

2. It is agreed betwixt the aboves<sup>d</sup> parties that in case any Englishman for  
the future shall happen to find any Cassyooke Indian killing either Cattle  
or Hogs that they shall be lawfull for the English to kill these Indian

3. It is agreed betwixt the afores<sup>d</sup> Parties that in case any Indian or Indians  
shall happen to kill any English man for the future (which God forbid)  
that then the said Indian with all that Company of Indians at that time which  
consented to the said Murder shall be deliv<sup>er</sup>ed up to the English there to be  
Proceeded against according to the Law of this Province

4. It is further agreed betwixt the abovesaid parties that in case any  
English man shall happen to die amongst the Cassayouke Indian that  
the said Indians bring them to Peter Meyers and that for every English  
man that they shall deliver they shall receive One Matchcoat  
Signed and delivered this The ninth of M<sup>o</sup> PINNA

Mem<sup>o</sup> That the aboves<sup>d</sup> Articles were signed Interchangably by the  
Gov<sup>r</sup> and Pinna and delivered this 19<sup>th</sup> of Sept<sup>r</sup> 1661
