Charles to George Talbot Esq^r greeting Our, Your special trust reposed in your Fidelity *Et* constant Courage and Circumspection and in your affection love and to our just and lawfull Interest We have thought fit to constitute and do hereby constitute Ordain and appoint you to be our Comm^{rs} for Disposall of Lands in New Ireland and the parts adjoining to the River and bay of Delaware on the west side thereof And to the Southward of the fortyth degree of Northern Latitude there to grant warrants in our Name for Lands not already Inhabited nor already sold out in our Name for Other persons to all effects Desiring the same according to the Tenor of the Instructions already delivered to you And likewise to Protect and defend to your utmost power the persons and Estates of all people in those parts who shall put themselves under the Protection of our Govern^{mt} according to your Instructions aforesaid And you are (in Cases of Urgent Necessity) to make use of the assistance of such a part of your Regiment of Horse, as you shall think necessary, You are also to treat and Intere in our Name with such persons living in those parts
