3- For all <sup>the</sup> Land soe taken up as aforesaid we do for our selves our heirs and  
Successors covenant and Agree to and with such persons as aforesaid taking up  
the same to pass our Grant under of great Seal of this our Province to him or them and his  
and their heirs and Assignes for ever in free and Common Soeage by Fruity only for all  
Services under of yearly rent of one Shilling the for every fifty Acres the reservation only  
of all Royal Mines (as is Used) Conditionally that if such Person or persons, grantee or gra-  
tees shall not within three years after such grant, pay and satisfy unto us or our heirs  
or Such Officer or Officers as aforesaid the Quantity of one hundred pounds of Tobacco for  
every fifty Acres as aforesaid the said Grant as to him or them refusing delaying or longer  
Delaying the same shall be to all Intents and purposes Void Null and of none Effect and the  
same free and Clear for any other Person or persons of what descent aforesaid to take up  
under of Great Services and Conditions aforesaid the said former Grant notwithstanding  
any <sup>provision</sup> ~~provision~~ also and it is our Intent and meaning that each Person particu-  
lar Part or Division of Land shall be by it self and particularly granted and patented

4- In Case you meet <sup>the</sup> an Obstruction or Opposition from our Neighbouring  
Colony Pennsylvania under of Government of W<sup>m</sup> Penn Esq: pretending claim to any  
the Places aforesaid or that any of Inhabitants thereof shall attempt to dis-  
turb or seize of Persons Cattle or goods of any Person or persons already Under our  
Government or willing to embrace of Same in Manner aforesaid You are then  
Immediately to Requint of Said W<sup>m</sup> Penn <sup>the</sup> therefor and demand Satisfaction of him  
made by of Party Offending <sup>in</sup> ~~in~~ <sup>the</sup> ~~the~~ (if of Same be done without his Direction  
knowledge or consent) he will most readily grant you. But in Case you find and  
shall be well satisfied that is done by his Order or Countenance you may then seek  
your own Satisfaction as near as may be by retaliating of Same Injury and Damage  
upon your Next Neighbour Inhabitants under his Government: <sup>in</sup> ~~in~~ <sup>the</sup> ~~the~~ but  
with as much prudence and Moderation as the Case will Admitt

5- And that you prevent of Inroadings of Inhabitants of Pennsylvania upon  
our Province and their Infesting <sup>the</sup> ~~the~~ under us you are to use your greatest  
Care Skill & Industry to procure the <sup>the</sup> ~~the~~ the uppermost parts thereof first as  
near as may be to the fourteenth degree to <sup>the</sup> ~~the~~ be as near as possible to prevent their  
Coming further down upon us

6- And for Encouragement of all such Persons as shall <sup>the</sup> ~~the~~ take to Seat, Inhabit  
& Maintain Christina Bridge you are <sup>the</sup> ~~the~~ and required and have hereby full power  
& Authority given you to Survey and lay out into Ten parts or Lots of Quantity of one  
thousand Acres of Land about of said Bridge, the same to be distributed to and amongst  
any Ten Persons of British or Irish descent, that will undertake and Endeavour  
to Seat of Same to be confirmed to them their heirs and Assignes for ever each of them  
one hundred Acres under of yearly Rent of Two Shillings per Royal Mines only  
reserved as aforesaid

7- And whereas we have heard that a certain Indian hath Publicly  
threatned your life (whether of his own Inclination or through of Instigation of  
others we know not) we therefore will that you use all diligent means and  
Cunning According to the best of your discretion to know the truth thereof, and to  
find out of Indian who we are informed belongeth to Delaware; if upon Inqui-  
ry made it appears to be, you are then with all privacy imaginable, and with  
what guard you think fit to goe to of Indian Town and <sup>the</sup> ~~the~~ that State or know  
they are within our Government and that you are come for us to demand of Del-  
aware of of Indian to be proceeded against according to our Lawes <sup>the</sup> ~~the~~ you expect  
from them as an Acknowledgement of their Subjection to us to be renewed yearly
