to take up again their said Plantations and

same with the quiet of their labours they do offer unto your
Majesty 1000 Pounds Annually viz. 50 for the said Isle of Kent and
50 for the said Plantation in the Tongue Country
to have there 12 Leagues of Land &c from the Mouth of the
said River and such like thereof down the said Bay southerly
to the said River and so to the head of the said River and to the
Grand Lake of Simuia to be held in fee from the Crown of Eng^t
and to be yearly paid unto your Majestys Exchequer to be
received according to the Laws of England with such Privileg
as your Majestys shall please to grant by which means
your Majestys may have a great Revenue annually and all
Planters will be encouraged to proceed chearfully on their
designs.

And the Petitioners having now a Ship ready to
desire with Goods and People for the prosecuting and mana-
ging of their said designes and Trade which without speedy
Assitance and your Majestys Gracious favour and Encouragement
is like to come to them with Great Loss.

May it therefore please your most Excellent Majestys
to Grant unto the Petitioners a confirmation of your
Majestys said Commission and Letter under your
Majestys Broad Seal for the quiet keeping enjoying
and Governing of the said Islands Plantations and
People therin as presented to send now with the said
Ship and to Refer the speedy examinations of the
said Wrongs and Injuries unto whom your Maj-^{est}
will please to think fit to certify your Majestys.
