

When to Supply the petitioners said Plantations and
to take Supplies thereof and sell themselves thereon

And the petitioners being desirous to propose a way
whereby Your Majesty may receive to the Crown for Plantations
an Annual Benefit and the Planters be content to enjoy the
same with the fruits of their labours they do offer unto your
Majesty two of Annam viz 50 for the said Isle of Kent and
50 for the said Plantation in the Saguenaw or
to have three 12 leagues of Land &c from the Mouth of the
said River on each side thereof down the said Bay Southward
to the Sea and up to the head of the said River and to the
Grand Lake of Amulic to be held on fee from the Crown of Engl^d
and to be yearly paid unto your Majesty's Exchequer to be
permitted according to the Laws of England with such Priviledges
as your Majesty shall please to grant By which means
Your Majesty may raise a good Revenue annually and all
Planters will be encouraged to proceed cheerfully on these
designs

And the petitioners having now a Ship ready to
depart with Goods and People for the prosecuting and manag-
ing of their said adventures and Trade which without speedy
Supply and your Majesty's gracious favour and Encouragement
is like to come to Ruin to their Great Loss

May it therefore please your most Excellent Majesty
to Grant unto the petitioners a Confirmation of your
Majesty's said Commission and Letter under your
Majesty's Broad Seal for the quiet keeping enjoying
and Governing of the said Islands Plantations and
People thereof as aforesaid to send now with the said
Ship and to Refer the speedy examinations of the
said Wrongs and Injuries unto whom your Majesty
shall please to think fit to Certify your Majesty.
