 Lieutenant General for the time being and the Vessels or  
 Commodities so seized to deliver to the Collector for our  
 Use General. Saint Marys this 8<sup>th</sup> of February 1709

To all people to whom these presents shall come I  
 Leonard Calvert by Lieutenant General of the Province  
 of Maryland send health in our Lord God Everlasting  
 whereas this present General Assembly began on the 25<sup>th</sup>  
 day of January last past and by several Adjournments  
 continued until the 8<sup>th</sup> of this instant month of Febr.  
 was then adjourned until the 26<sup>th</sup> of this instant month  
 now designing at this present to make an expedition in  
 person unto the Isle of Kent and doubting lest some  
 Accident might hinder my Return to Saint Marys  
 afore the said day whereby the Assembly would of it self  
 be dissolved for want of power to Assemble know ye there  
 fore that in case of such my Absence I have authorized  
 and deputed and do hereby appoint authorize and depute  
 Mr John Seeger Secretary in my <sup>and place</sup> name to hold and con  
 vene the said Assembly at the day appointed and to give  
 voice for me to all and only such things as he shall think  
 fit also to adjourn or dissolve the said Assembly as he shall  
 see cause and to do and perform all other things belonging  
 to the said Assembly as amply to all intents and purposes  
 as I myself might do if I were personally present
