 house by night any Indian without leave from us or our
 Lieutenant General or from yourself first Obtained and the
 Offender or Offenders herein to be laid over to answer the same
 at the next County Court to be held at Saint Marys and we
 do further Authorise him to elect and appoint some able
 and sufficient persons within your hundred to be high
 Constable of the same hundred to which persons so by you
 Elect and Nominated we do hereby Give full power and
 Authority to do and Execute all such Affairs and powers in
 the said hundred as unto the high Constable of a hundred
 in England do or may belong and we do Request and Com-
 munit all the Inhabitants of the said hundred that they
 do acknowledge respect and Obeey you the said Robert Win-
 four and the said high Constable by you to be appointed
 respectively in your several Offices and Charges hereby Com-
 mitted unto you and him as they will Answer the Con-
 trary thereof at their perill Given at Saint Marys this last
 day of March 1638 Writings Leonard Calvert &c²

 and keep in safe custody until you shall Receive further
 Order thereon from us or our Lieutenant General and where
 as we are informed that there is a wreck layed on the

 Authorise you to inquire and Examine touching the said
