Cecilius Lord Proprietary of the Province of Maryland Lord Baron of Baltimore &c to all persons to whom these presents shall come greeting know ye that we byposing especial trust and Confidence in the fidelity and wisdom of William Braithwaite Gentleman have Authorized and Appointed and by these presents do constitute Authorise and Appoint the said William Braithwaite to be Commander of the Isle of Kent in all matters of Warfare by Sea and Land necessary to the resistance of the Enemy or suppression of mutinies and insolences to do all such things as to the chief Captain and Commander do belong and appertaine until we shall signify Our Pleasure to the contrary and in all other matters
