the said William Branthwaite but do further amplye
and enlarge it Given unto him by this our present Com-
mission full power and authority by a precept under his
hand to summon and examine person being within our
said Island to answer many matters and litle or sumerall
and to hear and determine all suits of debt of what value
or demand soever the same shall be and if any person
shall be imbut of any debt either to our self or any other
by the confession and acknowledgement of the party how
self or by the verdict of such as shall try the matter to
award execution for all such several sums by a precept
under the hand of the said William Branthwaite which
precept we do hereby appoint shall be sufficient war-
rant to the Sheriff of our said Island to levy the said
several sums remaining in the receipt of Execution either
by distress and sale of the goods of the party against
whom the Execution shall be awarded otherwise by
Imprisonment of his person as the said Precept shall
