an Oath to him for the equal Administration of Justice &c

Then were Sworn Captain Thomas Commales Esq^r
W^m Giles Brent Gen^r W^m John Sawyer Gen^r in the form
appointed for Councillor to take upon the same bill

Then was Sworn the said John Sawyer in the Oath
Appointed for the Secretary

Then was chosen and Sworn for Sheriff and Coo-
ver Thomas Bulldridge for 1 Year

Then was chosen for Treasurer of the Province W^m
Giles Brent

Then the Governor Authorised the Secretary to
Administer to him the Oath of Allegiance as it is Recorded
in the Bill of the last Assembly intituled a Act for
Swearing Allegiance

Then the Governor administered the same Oath
to all the Council

April 13th

A Commission to Thomas Boys to arrest any Persons
Subjects or Guests unlawfully trading with the Indians
by Land or water
