 Northwards into the Woods five miles any where from the
 said Bank into a hundred by the name of Saint Clements
 hundred now to the end Capver and Rights and the Good
 Order of the Province may be the better maintained
 Exercised from time to time within the said hundred we
 relying much upon your prudence and diligent circum-
 spection do hereby by our warrant authorise you to be the
 conservator of our peace within the said hundred as well
 upon the land as upon the water adjoining to it with all
 powers and authorities belonging unto two Justices
 of peace in England by the law or usage of England au-
 thorising and without changing and requiring You to use
 all power and means necessary for the preserving of any
 our rights within the said Hundred either upon the land
 or water and to punish according to your discretion
 with imprisonment or fine not exceeding £ Tobacco
 with any corporal correction not extending to life or
 member any Offender against our said rights and spe-
 cially such as shall destroy or distract our Game of Herons
 upon Heron Island by unlawfully taking either the
 Fowl or Eggs or by shooting upon or near the said Is-
 land and to take to your own use the guns nets or any
 other Instruments used by any Offenders to the distin-
 tance or destruction of any of our Game as aforesaid and
 to apprehend and send to Saint Marys all unlawful
 Traders with the Indians and specially such as shall
 give or sell to any Indian any Arms or Ammunition
 and to see that the Inhabitants of the said hundred
 be provided of necessary and sufficient arms for their
 defence upon all occasions and to do all other things
 necessary for the Execution of the powers hereby committed
 unto you Given at St Marys
