ever to the said Office belonging and Appertaining us fully &
Intirely and in as ample manner and form as any other of
Our Surveyors ever heretofore had held or enjoyed the same
namely Surveyor of the Province of Virginia ever had held or
Enjoyed the said place and Office of Surveyor General in the
said Province of Virginia Commanding all to and firmly
by these presents Enjoining all and singular Sheriffs and
other our Officers Ministers and all other people within our
said Province of Maryland that they be Obedient Assisting
and Aiding to the said John Langford and his deputy or De-
puties in the execution of the aforesaid Office from time to time
as they shall be thereunto required and as becometh them
