what you have done herein as soon as you may and  
this shall be your warrant

Thus we do will and Require you to draw a  
Commission to Mr. Giles Brent to be Commander of the  
Isle of Rente and for Mr. William Suddington and for  
Mr. Richard Thompson to be Joined with him in Com-  
mission and to put the Great Seal to it and then send it  
to me to be signed and this shall be your Warrant
