 hundred and that all several persons of the said several hund-  
 reds able to bear arms be Obedient and Obedient unto the said  
 Several persons respectively appointed to take Charge & Com-  
 mand thereof as aforesaid as they will Answer the contrary  
 at their Perill and of all the several Commands aforesaid I do  
 hereby Require everyone to take notice so far as it may or shall  
 Concern them upon the several pains as by martial Law may  
 be inflicted upon the Contemners of an Ordinance so much  
 importing to the Common safety Given at St Marys this  
 28<sup>th</sup> August 1642
