And we do hereby promise and grant signify and declare
that all and every acquittance or other discharge under the hand
and Seal of the said John Peuger shall be to all and every the
people there within our said province a sufficient discharge
for such Rents Customs profits and other dues which shall
from time to time be paid unto him the said John Peuger for
our use Given under our Great Seal of our said Province of Ma-
ryland at our City of Saint Marys within our said Province
on the fifth day of September 1642

Conditions proounded by the Right Honourable Cecilius
Lord Baltimore Lord Proprietor of the Province of Maryland
in the name of America to such persons as shall adventure
or go to plant in the Province upon which conditions
are to begin from the feast of the Annunciation of the
Virgin Mary 1642 and to continue till new or other con-
ditions of plantation for the said Province shall be pub-
lished under his Lordships hand and Seal within the said
Province

In witness What person so ever being of British or Irish des-
cenc that shall be at the Charge to transport into the Province
of Maryland himself or his deputy with any number of able
Men between the ages of sixteen and fifty years of Age of the
descent aforesaid ^{provided} and furnished with Arms and Ammunition
according to a particular herunder express to any number of
Women between the ages of fourteen and forty there shall be
Granted unto every such Adventurer for every twenty persons
he shall so transport thither in one year a proportion of good
Land within the said Province containing in quantity two thousand
