to the head of Patuxent River and them to expell or vanquish
and put to death and their Arms or Goods to pillage and thereof
to dispose at your discretion and to pursue them to Eastern Shore
or thither to go to meet and prevent ^{if you may} them from coming out
upon the English and to pillage or destroy them or any other
mischief do unto them by War until shall obtain our
peace Require all Soldiers that shall go out with you dedi-
ent unto you in all parts as unto Captain as shall befit ac-
cording discipline martial at Perils Writings &c
