

the one of thirty pounds Sterling and the other of ten pounds
 Sterling to my said Brother which Bills are also (as I am
 informed) not accepted but protested also in the same man-
 ner as the other above mentioned whereupon some directions
 may ^{perhaps} respectively be sent thither to recover a satisfaction
 of all the said Bills to the respective pretendes therein with
 Costs and Damages but because for divers Reasons true and
 Right Justice cannot be done therein without some advice
 and testimonies from hence which cannot yet be had there-
 fore I thought fit and do hereby restrain the power of the
 said Giles Brent or any other person by Authority ^{derived} from him
 to Grant process or take Cognisance of any suit or Complaint
 whatsoever concerning him or any of the aforesaid Bills of
 Exc^o or to give or pronounce any judgment therein any thing
 contained within the above mentioned or any other Com-
 mission to the contrary ^{in anywise} notwithstanding but to suspend
 any proceedings ^{therein} till my arrival ^{there} which I shall not fail
 to do unto every person equal right and justice therein &
 do therefore hereby Require the said Giles Brent and all others
 whom it may Concern to Obeey my Order herein as they
 will answer the contrary at their utmost perills and I do
 hereby Require the said Giles Brent and my Secretary there
 or one of them to Cause this my declaration with all con-
 venient speed after their or either of their receipt hereof to
 be Recorded and published at the usual places of publick
 Orders within the said Province for the Government there
 Given under my hand and Seal the fourteenth day of
 July 1643 C. Baltimore
