my Brother Edward Oliver would have dispatched
this Office here was he might have returned into Maryland
again this Year I did for divers Reasons by a dispatch which
I then sent unto you restrain your power of affenting
unto any Law in my name and of Granting any Land
from me in that Province I have now upon confidence
of your Integrity and fidelity to me thought fit and I
do hereby give you full power and Authority to affent
from time to time in my name to any Law which at any
General Assembly of the Freemen of that Province shall
be thought fit by you to be enacted there in a sample manner
as my said Brother had power from me to do the same
while he was my Lieutenant General there and no other
wise that is to say and my true meaning is hereby to give
you power to make every such Law to be affented to
by you in my name to be in force within the said Pro
vince till I or my heirs shall signify our or their disaffent
