 Lieutenant General Admiral Marshall Chief Captain &
 Commander as well by Land or by sea of our said Province
 of Maryland and the Islands to the same belonging and
 to by these presents grant unto him the chief commandment
 and absolute Authority land and water matters of warfare
 by Land and Sea to execute and administer the same
 to the Resistance of the Enemies or Suppression of mutinies
 and insurrections as our said Lieutenant shall think most
 commodious for the preservation of our said Province
 and to do all such other things as do belong or appertain
 to the Office of a Lieutenant General Admiral Marshall
 Chief Captain & Commander in as large and ample man-
 ner wall intents and purposes as we our self might do
 if we were personally present by force or virtue of the
 Letters patent soe granted by our Sovereign Lord
 King Charles under the Great Seal of England Bearing
 date at Westminster 20th June 8 Year of his Majestys Reign
 whiche wold execute and Administer the same with such
 and as ample power and Authority as we if we were per-
 sonally present might do or execute the same by force or vir-
 tue of the Letters patent aforesaid until we shall signify
 Our pleasure to the contrary and we do hereby further
 Ordain and Command all such as shall hereafter be worn
 of our Council within our said Province of Maryland all
 Captains Officers and Soldiers as well by Land as by Sea
 whom it doth or may concern all our Officers Receivers
 Bailiffs Marshalls and all other persons whatsoever
 within our said Province of Maryland of what quality
 or condition soever that they and every of them acknow-
 ledge the said Sir Leonard Calvert in the quality of our Lieutenant
 General Admiral Chief Captain & Commander over all our
