There are in his Lordships Name to prohibit all and every the Inhabitants of this Province to lend sell or Barter any Arms or Ammunition whatsoever unto any Indians within this Province without leave first had from the Governor of the Province for the time being and to authorize any Inhabitant of this Province who shall meet with any Indian within this Province without the said License having with him any ammunition to take the same from him and to deliver the same to the Governor for the time being and likewise to prohibit all the said Inhabitants of this Province to entertain or receive into their houses without the aforesaid License any Indians whatsoever as they will Answer the contrary at their perill Given at West St Georges the 13 of November 1644

There are to will you and withall to authorize you to take the Command of 8 men and a Shallop and to prest w fill up that number and to employ them in Service at the Isle of Kent according to Instructions and to require the said persons to obey you in all things accordingly that shall appertain to that service

1 You are with all the speed you may to repair with your Company to the Isle of Kent according to Instructions and if Wind & weather permit after you are past Flatusent River to make over for the East Side of the Bay and to keep that Side to the others Island in such Secret manner as you may to keep your Shallop from being discernd at Kent
