 Leonard Calvert and John Seuger or to whom you two shall  
 Appoint what is or shall be due unto me from them or any  
 of them so refusing and to Give Acquittance in my name  
 & Behalf for what you shall Receive from time to time by Vir-  
 tue of this warrant w<sup>ch</sup> acquittances I do hereby declare shall  
 be as Valid against me my heirs Executors and Administrators  
 as if I my self had been present and had signed and sea-  
 led the same Given under my hand and Seal at Arms at  
 Stook this 15<sup>th</sup> November Anno Domini 1646
