

but that immediately after the knowledge of any arrival of any person or vessel coming into the County of Saint Michaels they give notice thereof to me as soon as may be and Warn all persons so coming to come to the Fort to me before they entertain any communication with any person of the Province this Proclamation to be in force in every hundred immediately after the publishing thereof in the hundred and to continue in force for 1 month from the date of it & all men after the publication to take notice of it and Observe it in every point so far as it shall concern them upon pain of death or such other penalties as the Offence shall deserve in the Judgment of a martial Court a fineing all persons that I intend to take a very strict Account of all Offences to the contrary hereof Given at Saint Inigo's Fort this 16 January 1646

Renewed for 1 month more 12 february 1646 especially prohibiting export, cattle or corn

You are to inform yourself by all means you may ^{see} if it shall be needful by the oath of any person or persons other then the parties themselves what Goods imported since the last meeting of Assembly have been sold or Vended within Saint Clements or New Town hundred by Ralph Beane or any other and what inhabitants of those hundreds have been aboard the ships of the said Ralph Beane since her last coming out of Virginia and to Certify unto me the Names of all such persons and the sorts and quantities of all such Goods as have been vended as aforesaid and further to inquire in manner as aforesaid what quantities of wine or hott water have been vended by the said Ralph Beane or any other since the said vessels last coming as aforesaid and if you find that any hath been vended
