Warrant to tenants Lordships hundred St Clements and  
New Town to pay Rent before 4<sup>th</sup> February at 4. Foot perill  
District and Charges & head corners

January 27<sup>th</sup> 1646

Warrant to Lieutenant to take all Boats in hundred  
New Town & Saint Clements except not liable to be mull  
up to the Breach of Proclamation and to drive all Cattle  
in Saint Clements hundred belonging to others then self  
separately 2 or 3 to dispose to and to  
distrain Warrant Walsgrave 12 Bunches Corn areas three  
Years

January 27<sup>th</sup> 1646

Warrant to Robert Smith and Thomas Jewell by  
the Governor to pardon them all Offences past to this day  
if Submit before 4<sup>th</sup> February and take Oath of Fealty

February 1<sup>st</sup> 1646

The Governor repeated the power which he formerly  
Gave to Mr Britton C<sup>th</sup> for signing of writts and adminis-  
tring of Oaths

## Commission for the Commander of Kent

Know all men by these presents that I Leonard Cal-  
vert Esq Governor and Captain General of the Province  
of Maryland under the Right honble the Lord Propriety  
of the same reposing special trust and Confidence in  
the Fidelity and Prudence of Robert Baughan Gent by  
virtue of his Lordships Commission authorising me there-  
unto do constitute Ordain and Appoint the said Robert  
Baughan to be chief Captain and Commander under me  
the said Lordships General of all the militia of the Isle  
of Kent and with it to command and execute whatsoever
