any of the late Rebels on the Island of Kent and fled from  
thence or that is yet remaining in the said Island and  
hath refused to take the Oath of Fealty to his Lordship to  
be attached and kept in safe Custody by some Officer to be  
appointed by you until every of the said persons respectively  
shall appear before me and the Council of this Province at  
Saint Marys to answer their several Crimes of Rebellion  
and refusall of the said Oath and abide Judgment of Law  
therein Given at the Isle of Kent April 20<sup>th</sup> 1647

These are to authorize and require you to collect demand  
and Receive for the use of the Right Hon<sup>ble</sup> the Lord Pro-  
prietary of this Province all Customs Confiscations Forfeitures

& to be accountable to me therefore and for so doing this shall  
be your Commission Given at Saint Trigos this 31<sup>st</sup> May  
Anno 1647
