Captain John Price Captain of the Fort of St Inigos
made the Governor acquainted that there was great want
of Coin in the said Fort towards the maintainance of the
Soldiers and desired the Governor to take some speedy Course
to Supply the said want and it was Ordered by the Gov^t
that all such Coin as should be in any ones possession within
the Province more then for his own and his Families pro-
per use should be pressed at the rate of 120^l per Barrel
being at this time the common rate within the Province
upon his Lordships Account and for the maintainance
of the said Fort

These are in his Lordships name to require and Au-
thorise you to take up and press upon his Lordships
Acc^t for the use and maintainance of the Fort of St In-
igos five Barrels of Coin belonging to Gilbert Fenwick Gent
and deliver it to Captain John Price Captain of the said
Fort and to Certify what you have done therein unto the
Register of the Court and for so doing this shall be your
Commission Given at Saint Inigos Fort this 18 June
1647
