

and Whom he foresaid lying to the Custard of this pro-
 vince and then and there to employ his utmost endeavours
 Skill and force by what means he may in destroying
 the said Nations as well by Land as by water either by kil-
 ling them taking them Prisoners burning their Houses
 destroying their Corn or by any other means (as in his
 best discretion) he shall judge convenient and I do hereby
 Require him the said Captain John Price that he make
 no distribution or division of any Murther or pillage
 whatsoever which shall be gained or taken by any Soldier
 or Soldiers during the said Voyage from any the aforesaid
 Indians until he shall arrive at St Inigo's Fort & there
 Given a just Acco^t of all such Murther or pillage aforesaid
 to me or some other whom I shall appoint and I do fur-
 ther declare the said Captain John Price to be chief Captain
 or Commander of all such forces as he shall take with
 him during the said Service Giving him the said Captain
 John Price full power and Authority hereby to appoint
 such Officer or Officers for the good Ordering and managing
 the said Service intended as he in his best discretion shall
 judge needful and convenient requiring all and every one
 who shall go along with him to be aiding and assist
 unto him the said Captain John Price upon all Occasions
 whatsoever in the quality of chief Captain or Commander
 upon pain of such punishment and Censures to be inflict-
 ed upon them and every of them as such Contempt and
 disobedience in the Judgment of a Martial Court shall
 deserve given at St Inigo's Fort under my hand and
 the Seal of the province this 4th July Anno 1647
