

Remain unpaid to either these are with and by the Order
of Mr^r Margaret Brent Attorney for the Lord Proprietor to
Authorise the said Mr Thomas Copley to Receive all the
Rents and profits of the said Tenements and Lands under
Condition that if the said Land upon determination of
the difference between the said Lord Proprietary and the said
Mr Copley shall Remain to him the said Lord Prop^r
that then the said Mr Copley and his Successors shall
make good all the said Rents and profits to the said
Lord Prop^r or his heirs or assigns

Whereas it is publicly known to all the Inhabitants
of Kent that in the late Rebellion of that Island John
Gresham of that Island Planter was a partaker with the
Rebells and a principal and Active Instrument to main-
tain the said Rebellion of foot and whereas the said John
Gresham notwithstanding the late Governors pardon
published on the Isle of Kent 16 April 1647 and the last
pardon also published by Thomas Green Esq^r Governor of
this Province and bearing date at St^t Maries 4 Martij 1647
in that case favourably provided that all persons whatsoever
interested in the aforesaid Rebellion (Richard Ingle Maunier
only Excepted) expressing sorrow for their fact and coming
and craving for their pardon before Michaelmas last past
should have their pardon for their Offence committed as
aforesaid which notwithstanding the said John Gresham
persisting in his ill mind as doth appear hath Contem-
ned and neglected to sue for these are therefore to require
and Authorise all Sheriffs belonging unto this Province
if at any time they shall find the said John Gresham
within their district that they shall use a Rebell apprehend
