These are to give notice to all persons to whom it may
 Concern that I do hereby (for special Reasons me thereunto
 moving) suspend and revoke all power and Authority
 of Command upon the Isle of Kent from Captain Robt
 Laughan the Commander of the said Island and do acquit
 and discharge all the Inhabitants of the said Island
 from their Obedience formerly due unto his Command un-
 til they shall be thereunto required again by special Com-
 mission from the Governor of this Province for the time
 being and I do further hereby Require and Authorise
 Mr Philip Copner one of the Commissioners of the said
 County of Kent to issue forth all writts and procefses necessary
 for the Administration of Justice on the said County con-
 ding all parties interested over to the Provincial Court at
 Saint Marys there to have tried and determined their
