next reinforcing all Writts Warrants or other process

to this Court until the 5<sup>th</sup> of February and all Jurors &  
others warned upon summons bound to attend this Court  
are to take notice hereof and Give their attendance at  
the Court to be held at Saint Marys on the 5<sup>th</sup> of February  
as a fore Given at Saint Marys this 8<sup>th</sup> January 1648

Whereas Thomas Copley Gentleman born  
is a Recusant and may be Subject to be troubled for his Re-  
ligion and forasmuch as we are well Satisfied of the Con-  
dition and quality of the said Thomas Copley and of his  
Loyalty and Obedience towards us we do hereby will and  
Require you and every of you whom it may concern to  
permit and further the said Thomas Copley freely and  
Quietly to abide in any place and to go about and follow  
his Occasions without molesting or troubling him by any  
means whatsoever for matter of Religion or the place or  
persons unto whom he shall Reside and this shall be your  
warrant in this behalf Given under our Signet at our flat  
lace of Westminster the tenth day of December in the tenth  
Year of our Reign
