the Enrollment or Registry thereof shall be from time to
time a sufficient Warrant and discharge to You our Secy
and other Officers there for the performancethereof as afores
Given under our hand and Greater Seal at Wm the 4th
day of March in the eighteenth Year of our Dominion over
the said Province Anno Domini 1649
